



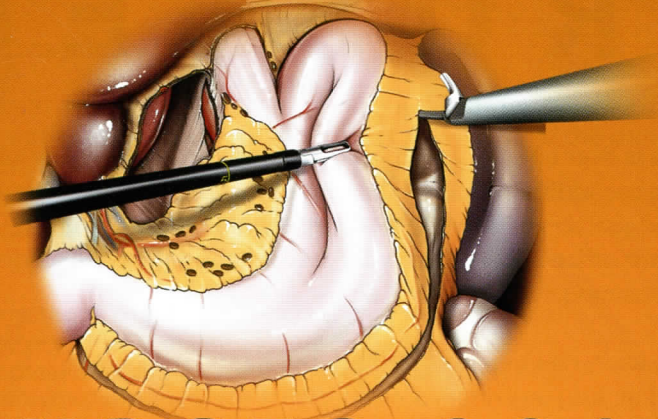

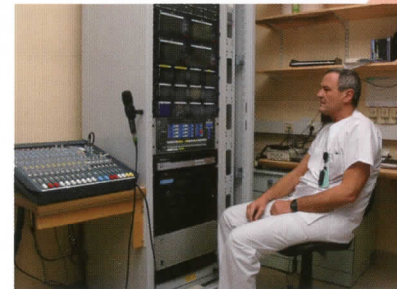

# BARIATRIC SURGERY

## COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Bariatric surgery has caused a new boom in the field of laparoscopic indications. Is the approach justified? Are all patients candidates? Which operation must be chosen? Participants will understand the several laparoscopic approaches of bariatric surgery, having the opportunity to view different live cases in the operating room: gastric bypass, sleeve gastrectomy, duodenal switch, and biliopancreatic diversion. Two courses will be only developed on reoperations (redo) for failed or complicated procedures.

## COURSE OBJECTIVES:

- Review common guidelines in bariatric surgery
- Show different procedures, tailored to the patients' needs
- Show techniques and strategies to reduce operative time and postoperative complications
- Comment on tricks and pitfalls in the different procedures
- to provide escape routes in case of peroperative mishaps
- Choose a new bariatric procedure in case of failed or complicated previous surgery
- Manage early and late postoperative complications

# TRANSORAL FOREGUT SURGERY (TOFS)

## COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Recent developments in endoluminal and transluminal procedures suggest that, in the near future, general surgeons will need to be well grounded in flexible endoscopy. This course gives the possibility to have an endoscopic approach to the pathology of the upper gastrointestinal tract: gastroesophageal reflux disease, bariatric surgery and early gastric cancer.

## OBJECTIVES:

- To describe the technique to treat the GERD by endoluminal fundoplication (EsophyX)
- To practice an endoscopic suture
- To show the benefits and results of this new approach

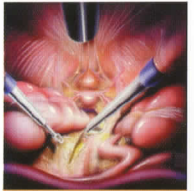
# COLORECTAL SURGERY

## COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This two-day session tackles a number of questions and issues, including whether laparoscopic colectomy should be performed in all cancer patients, and what to do in the case of total mesorectal excision (TME). The course also addresses the question of whether or not trocar site recurrences are a myth, and what the approach for a benign disease should be. Participants observe live left hemicolectomy, right hemicolectomy and TME being carried out.

## COURSE OBJECTIVES:

- Review the anatomy of the region in the context of a laparoscopic approach.
- Give general strategies for laparoscopic colorectal surgery.
- Teach best practices and avoidance of pitfalls in the various procedures.
- Explain potential long-term functional problems and how to avoid them to explore the holy plan of Bill Heald.

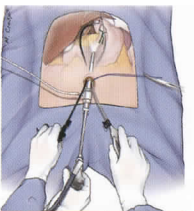
# SINGLE INCISION SURGERY

## COURSE DESCRIPTION:

With the era of the new philosophy of laparoscopic reduced port surgery, laparoscopy can appear less invasive if the number of the abdominal incisions is reduced. The umbilicus represents a well-healed natural scar allowing access to the peritoneal cavity through a single incision. The main advantage of the single-incision approach is the "scarless surgery" with an obvious cosmetic result, and other benefits. Hence the standard laparoscopic procedures can be performed with this technique.

## COURSE OBJECTIVES:

- Show classical laparoscopic procedures usually reduced by 4, 5 trocars performed through a single-incision in the umbilicus or suprapubically.
- Review different instruments.
- Memorize the tricks of this approach.

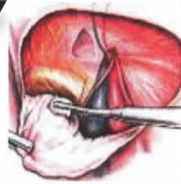

## COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Participants will have the opportunity to view live TEP and TAPP procedures as well as incisional and primary abdominal wall hernia repair by laparoscopic approach.

Different techniques of laparoscopy, including reduced port and single incision will be showed.

## COURSE OBJECTIVES:

- Review the relevant anatomy of the groin, viewed by the laparoscope.
- Show the two approaches in laparoscopic inguinal hernia repair, their indications and contraindications.
- Show how to cut back on costs.
- Show tricks and pitfalls in all of these procedures.

# 14TH NURSING DAY

## COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Laparoscopy has tremendously increased the role of nursing staff around and during a surgical procedure. This one-day session helps participants decide how much of the nursing staff should be familiarized with these techniques, whether such surgery should be performed during the night (in case of emergency) and how to reorganize a nursing staff to support laparoscopic procedures. The course also covers the solution of technical problems relating to the laparoscopic tower and laparoscopic instruments. Participants explore all aspects of laparoscopy including materials used.

## COURSE OBJECTIVES:

- Teach nursing staff to manage everything that is not in the operative field itself, so that the surgeon only has to deal with the internal cavity.

# TEACHING AT DISTANCE

## E-LEARNING

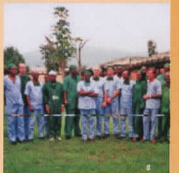
The faculty can give recorded teaching, provide information to the data bank, and supply answers to questions from students by email. The faculty gives direct teaching in front of the camera while performing live procedures that are broadcasted to the attendees. The student has the opportunity to either check the pre-recorded teaching material at home or to attend the live teaching in the auditorium. When students perform their first procedure on their own, the surgeon-teacher can mentor by videoconference. This form of teaching allows the surgeon to follow the procedure on his screen and to give recommendations to the students accordingly.



## TEACHING IN AFRICA

Our School organises one week teaching sessions in african countries, upon their request. The team provides laparoscopic equipment as well as videoconferencing tools. They demonstrate actual operative procedures, assist with training on a pelvic simulator and allow local surgeons to scrub in with their operations. Burundi, Congo, Rwanda, Cameroun, Sénégal, Mali, Burkina Faso, Gabon, Ivory Coast, Madagascar and Guinea have already benefited from this endeavour, which was made possible in a large part thanks to the help of the STORZ company.

## COLLABORATION WITH "WEBTELESURGERY PLATFORM"

"Webtelesurgery.com" is a online free platform for training, education, communication of surgery, specially laparoscopic surgery. It has been created by Prof Cavit AVCI in Istanbul and is managed by an "International Educational and Evaluation Board". Its main objective is the editing and dissemination of medico-surgical knowlege, in collaboration with major Scientific Associations and Centers of Excellence in Europe and other countries. The choice of transmission method is "a low-bandwidth Internet-based system" which assures the teletransmission in optimal quality of video to a very large number of regions with a lack of terrestrial communication infrastructure.

Our School and "Webtelesurgery Platform" have established a partnership to disseminate the courses or special teaching sessions organized by our team at distance.



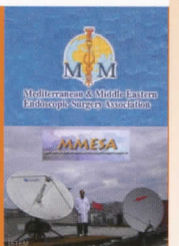
